My dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

With a heart full of gratitude and hope, I share joyful news with you: 2026 will be a sacred and grace-filled year for our parish as we celebrate **50 years of God's abundant blessings**. Fifty years of faith lived and shared. Fifty years of prayer, unity, sacrifice, and love. Fifty years of God walking faithfully with His people.
